Head: Understanding the Bible

- 1) What did you think of this statement: "Gathered worship is the primary and ordinary way that God meets with and changes his people"? Agree? Disagree?
- 2) What ways have you seen other churches begin a worship service? What is communicated by beginning our worship service with a Call to Worship from the Scriptures?
- 3) Read 1 Peter 2:4-12. How did we find ourselves in God's presence in conversion, according to Peter?
- 4) Reflect on the image of darkness. What was our plight before coming to faith in Jesus? What is life like in the darkness?

Heart: Using the Gospel on Our Affections

Question: What is effectual calling? Answer: Effectual calling is the work of God's Spirit, whereby, convincing us of our sin and misery, enlightening our minds in the knowledge of Christ, and renewing our wills, he doth persuade and enable us to embrace Jesus Christ, freely offered to us in the gospel.

- 5) Peter describes Jesus as a cornerstone in a spiritual house. He is the centerpiece and foundation of God's temple, His dwelling place. What does the cornerstone look like to those who do not believe? Why?
- 6) How do we, coming from darkness, come to see Jesus, as "chosen and precious."? What makes Jesus, the Light of the World, attractive to us? (See 2 Corinthians 4:6)

Hands: Applying the Gospel to Our Lives
